By signing this application, I do certify that I have been a REALTOR® or REALTOR-Associate® member for a total of 40 years and have served either my local, state or national association as an officer or director or by serving on a local, state or national committee for at least one year.

Please note, after 2014, qualification for REALTOR Emeritus will change to also require at least:

- One (1) year of service at the National Association level. However, for applications filed through 2019, the one (1) year service requirement may also be met through service at the state or local level. This provision will sunset at the end of 2019.

REALTOR Emeritus applications submitted:

- In the years 2015 through 2019 will require proof of one (1) year of service* at the local, state, or National Association level.
- In 2020 and beyond will require proof of one (1) year of service* at the National Association level.
